- 6) What "theme" from the first sermon is repeated in the second one? (vv. 13b-15) How "specific" does Peter get in his recitation of the facts surrounding Jesus' death?

- 7) How was the lame man healed? (v. 16a) *Thought question:* whose faith?

- 8) What does Peter "admit" on behalf of his audience? (v. 17) How did their "ignorance" factor into the overall plan of God? (v. 18) Did this "ignorance" excuse them? (v. 19a)

- 9) What "benefits" awaited them if they repented? (vv. 19b-21)

- 10) Once again, how does Peter "prophetically prove" the truths he is preaching? (vv. 22-24) Who does he quote this time?

- 11) How does Peter connect his audience with these prophets? (v. 25) What "promise" is mentioned? (cp. Gen. 12:3; Gal. 3:16)

- 12) Despite the promise for "all nations," how does Peter emphasize the ethnicity of his audience? (v. 26; cp. Rom. 3:1-2)
