

Isaiah 1-39

Isaiah preached to Israel and Judah. Isaiah told the people that God saw all of the wicked things the people were doing. They were worshipping idols and behaving badly! God had to punish the wicked so that everyone would know that He was a fair and just God.

Even though God would punish Israel and Judah for their wickedness, Isaiah told of a time when great things would happen. The Word of God would go out from Jerusalem (2:1-4). A Child would be born who would rule on the throne of David (9:6-7). Do you remember the promise God made to David (2 Samuel 7:12-13)? After all this time, God had not forgotten His promise to David! This son would have the Spirit of God (11:1-8). This Son would love obeying God and He would save everyone.

God told all the nations of the world that He would punish their wickedness just as Israel and Judah would be punished for their evil ways. God shows that He is God of all the world, not just Israel and Judah. Isaiah told them that God would punish **all** the people who did not obey God!

God was angry with His people because they refused to be taught God's Word (28:9-10). The people did not ask for wisdom or help from God. They asked other nations for help (30:1-5). God told His people that they had no way to defeat the Assyrians! Only God could help them, but they had to turn back to Him (30:27-33)!

The land would be devastated, but God told of a time when He would bless them again. God would save them and protect them. A time would come when they would sing and be happy (35:8-10).

Main Points:

1. God **will** punish the wicked!
2. God keeps His promises.
3. God will take care of us **IF** we will obey Him!
