- 7) What else has God done for man? (**vv. 12-13**; cp. **2:24**)

God's Will Cannot Be Thwarted (3:14-15)

- 8) How does Solomon describe God and His "purpose" (will) for man? (**v. 14**) How have we often referred to this same principle re: God's word? (**Josh. 1:7-8**; **Mt. 24:35**; **Rev. 22:18-19**)

- 9) Be able to explain the last phrase of v. 15.

Solomon Saw Oppression (4:1-3)

- 13) What is the 2nd "puzzling" thing Solomon saw in a world under God's sovereign control? (v. 1)
Based on this verse, why was he puzzled?

- 14) What erroneous conclusion does Solomon reach in vv. 2-3? What 2 groups of people does he mention?

Solomon Saw Envy, Rivalry (4:4-6)

- 15) What is the 3rd "puzzling" thing Solomon saw in a world under God's sovereign control? (v. 4)
Who is the "overachiever" contrasted with? (v. 5)

- 16) What is Solomon's conclusion re: this "puzzle?" (v. 6; cp. Prov. 15:16-17; 16:8; Phil. 4:11)

Solomon Saw Loneliness (4:7-12)

- 17) What is the 4th "puzzling" thing Solomon saw in a world under God's sovereign control? (vv. 7-8)
What is the answer to this problem? (vv. 9-12; cp. Gen. 2:18)

- 18) How is the value and worth of others in vv. 9-12 emphasized when compared to those mentioned in v. 1 and v. 4?

Solomon Saw Fickleness, Partiality (4:13-16)

- 19) What is the 5th "puzzling" thing Solomon saw in a world under God's sovereign control? (vv. 13-16) How does fickleness actually show itself? (v. 16)

- 20) Thought question: is there any possibility Solomon is referring to himself in these verses?

- 23) How did Jesus illustrate the vanity of words used in worship? (Mt. 6:7)

The Danger Of Becoming Materialistic (vv. 10-17)

- 26) What is the 3rd "danger" Solomon lists in questioning God's sovereign control? (vv. 10-17) Compare this to his earlier exhortation. (2:8-11)

- 27) What is the preferred "lifestyle?" (v. 12) What can happen to the rich? (v. 14) What certainty will no amount of riches change? (vv. 15-16; cp. 1 Tim. 6:7)

His Conclusions (vv. 18-20)

- 28) How does Solomon once again reach "above the sun" to conclude this section? (vv. 18-20) How does this compare with his earlier "conclusion?" (2:24-26)

- 29) What will the godly man not focus on? (v. 20a) Instead, where will be his emphasis?
