

Isaac's Wells

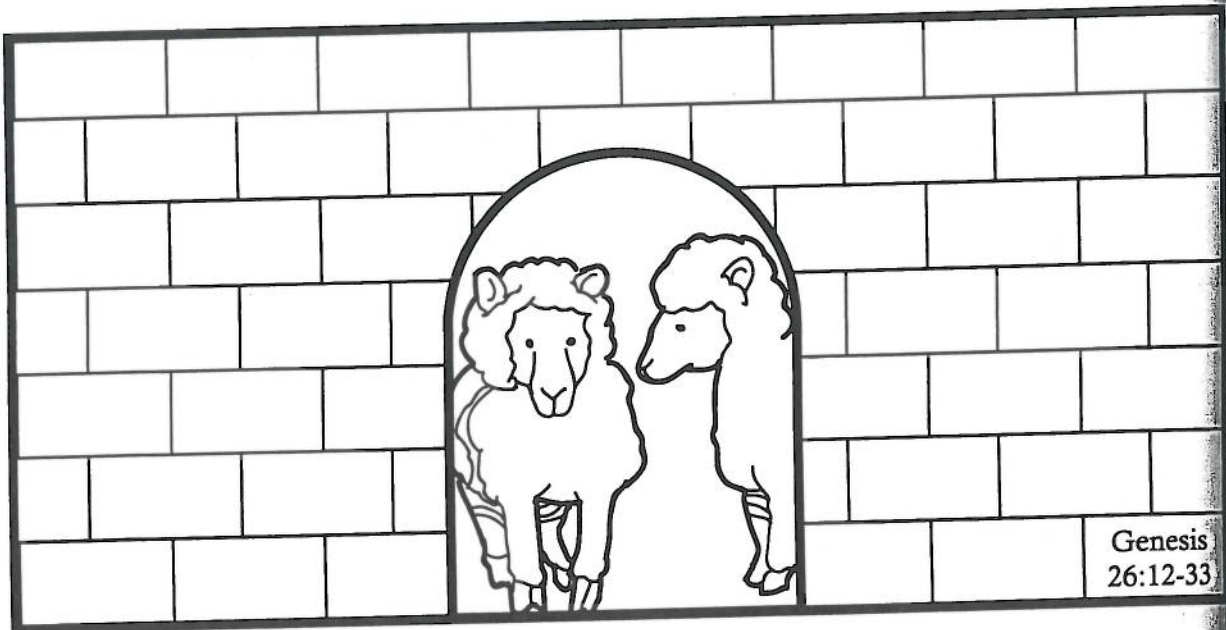
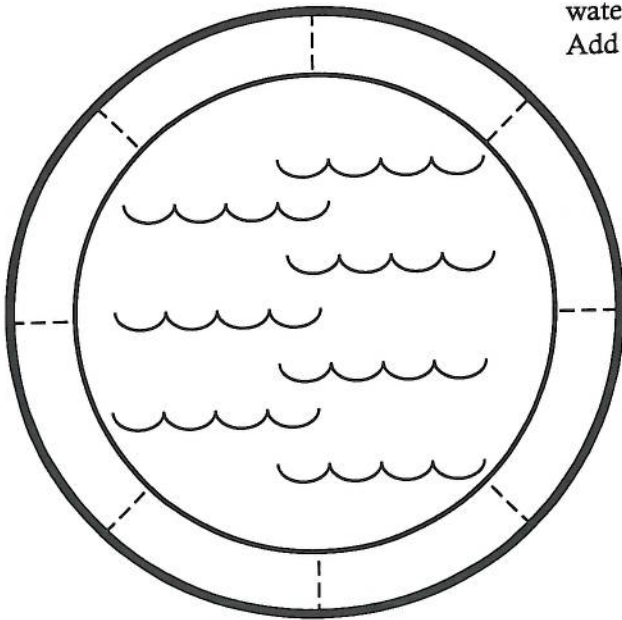
Genesis 26:12-33

"I will bless you," God told him.

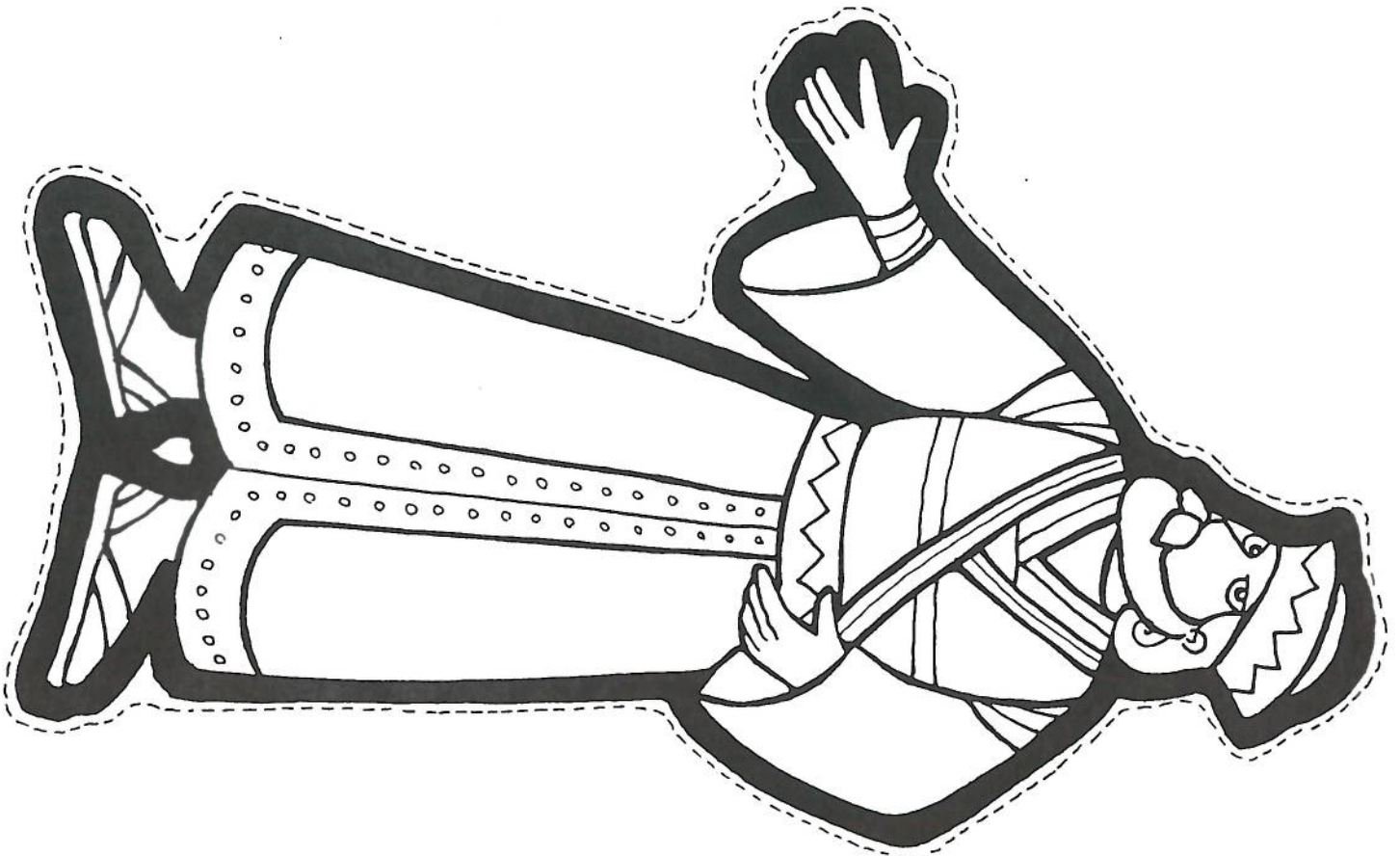
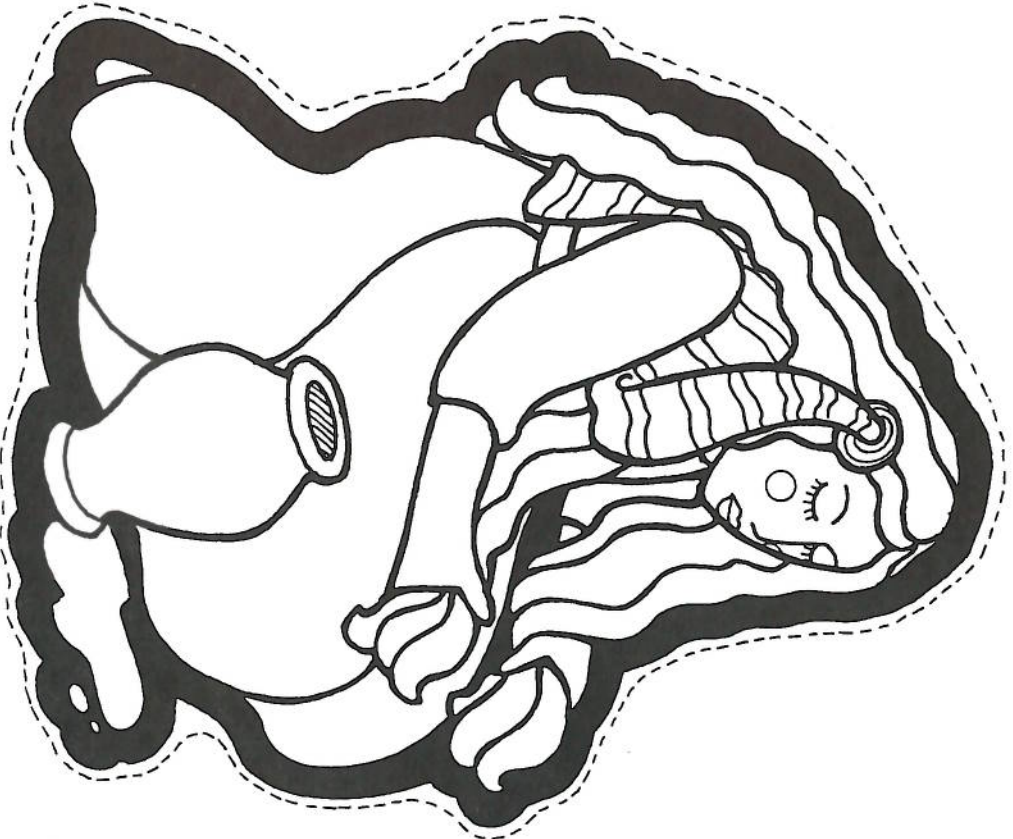
Color the water blue. Your teacher will help you put the water in your well. Glue the stone picture around the well. Add fluffy cotton to the lambs.
