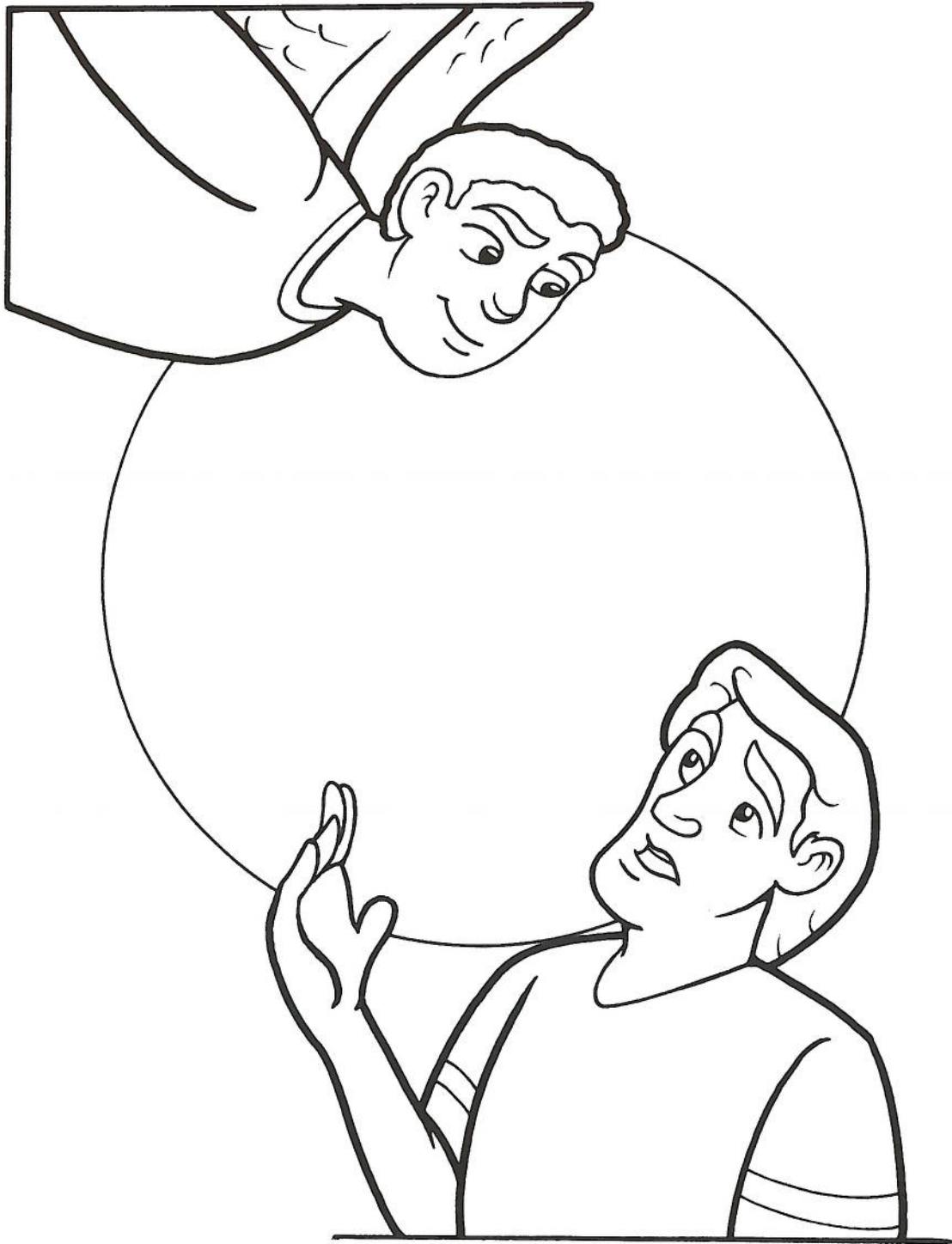


27. YOUR NAME SHALL BE ISRAEL (GENESIS 32:22-32)

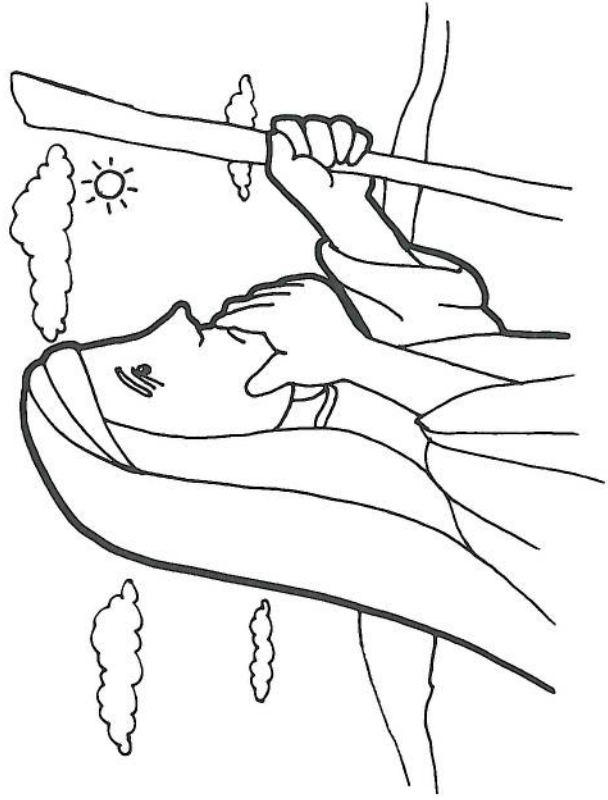

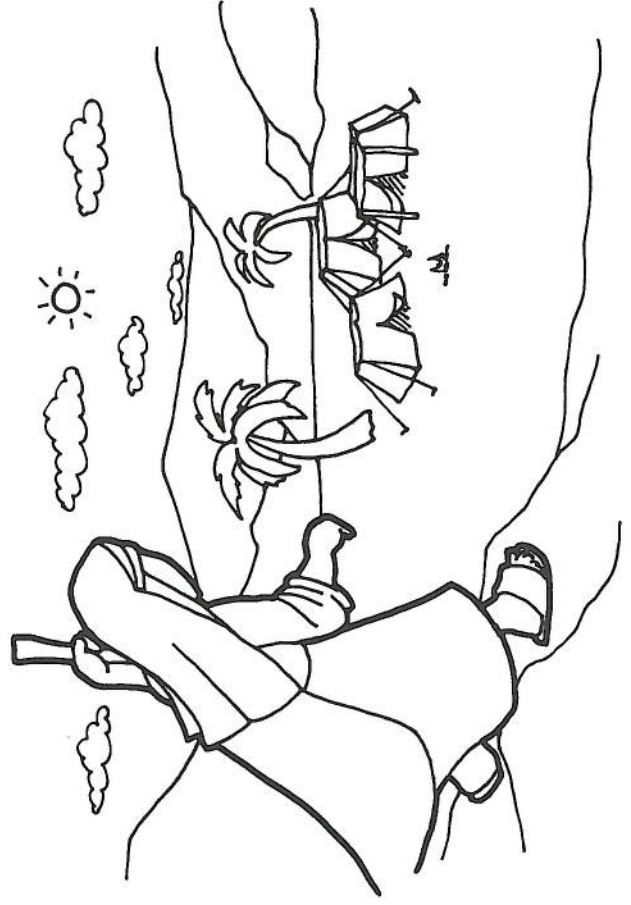
After years away from his family,
