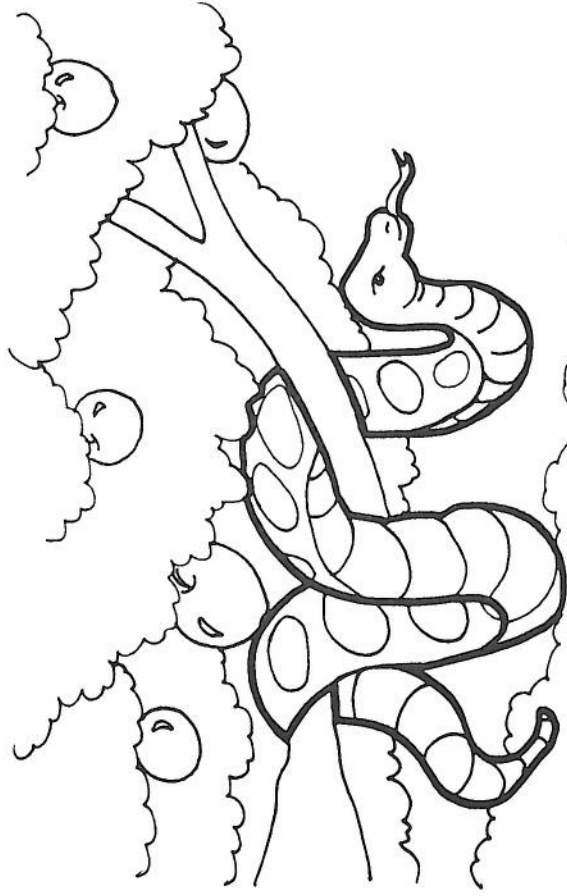
Because the Lord knew what was good for Adam and Eve, He gave them rules to follow.

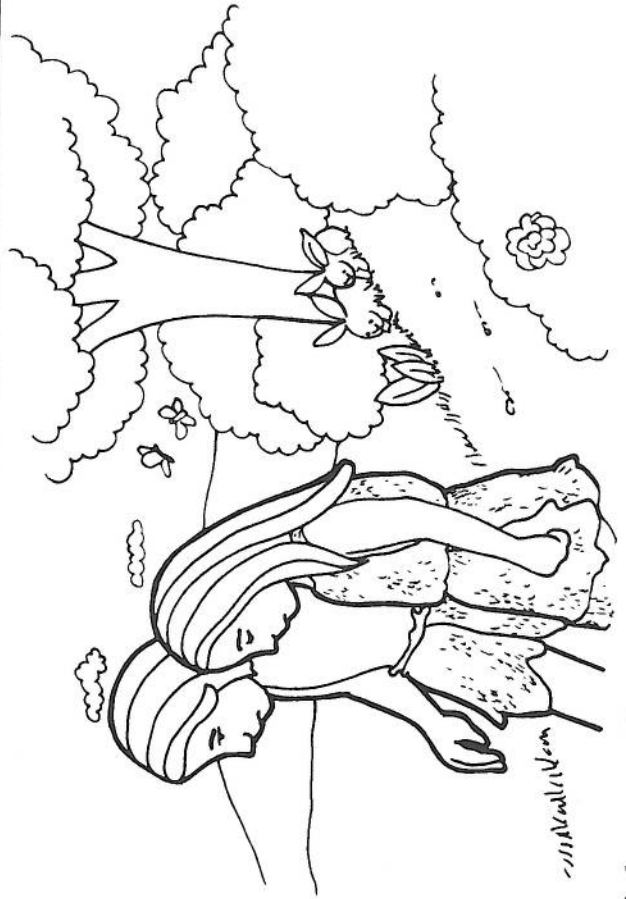
Satan influenced Adam and Eve to doubt what God had told them. "Did God really say that?" he asked.
