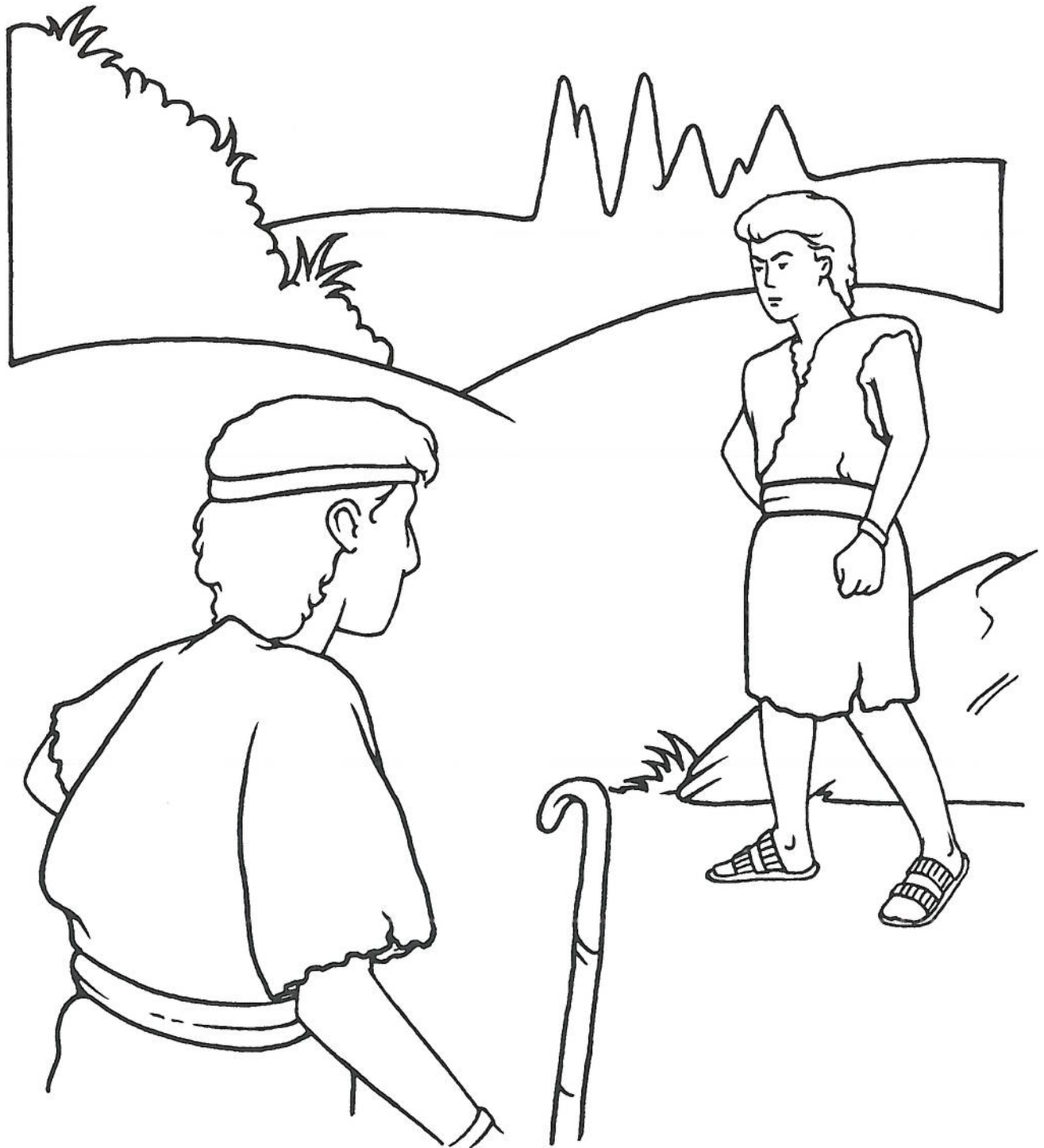


## 5. CAIN AND ABEL (GENESIS 4:1-17)



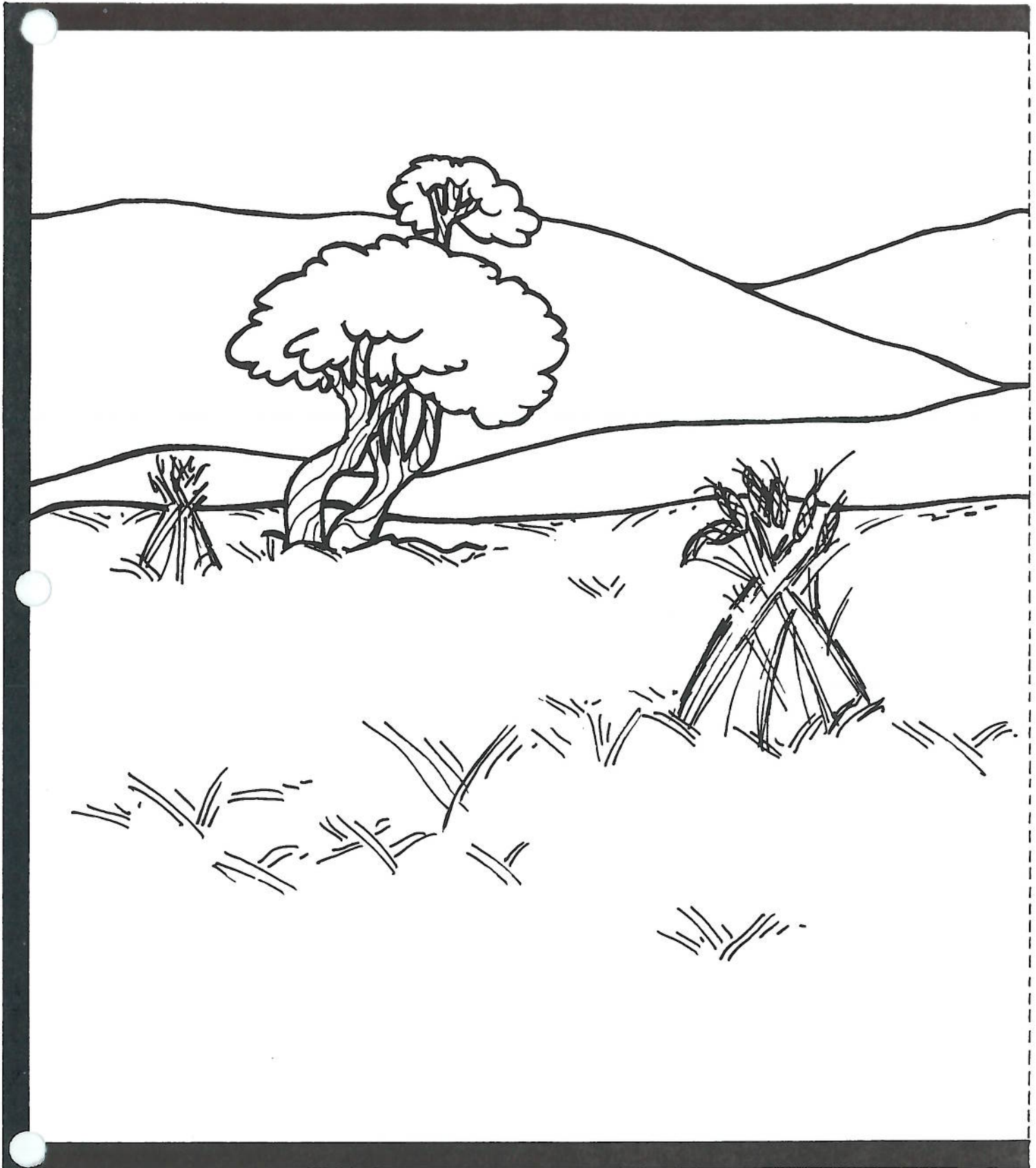
"Now Cain talked with Abel his brother; and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose against Abel his brother and killed him."

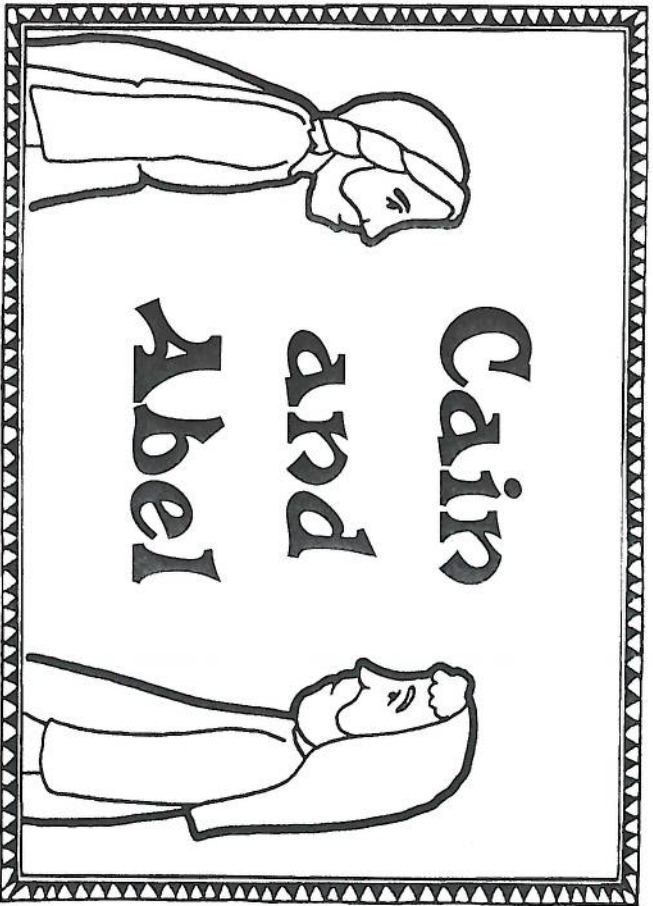
