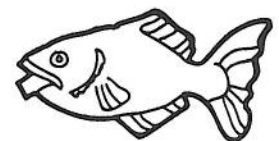
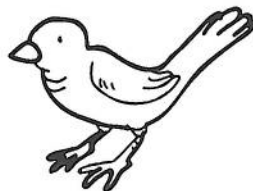
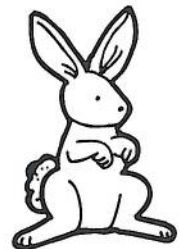
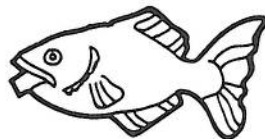
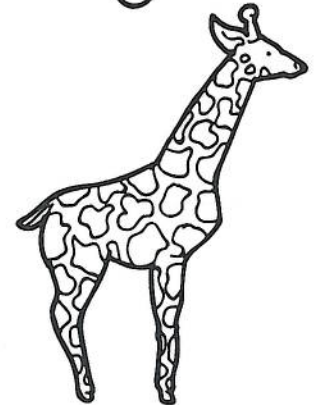
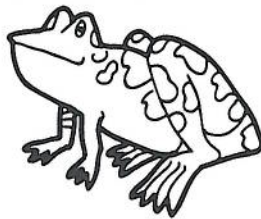
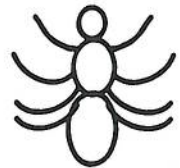
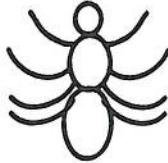
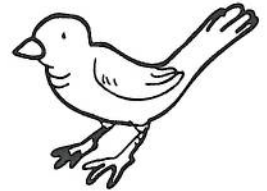
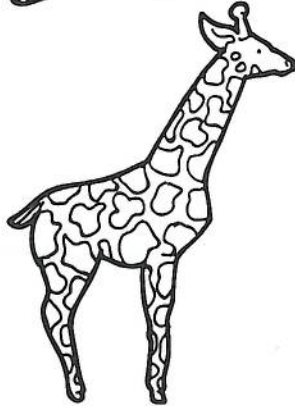
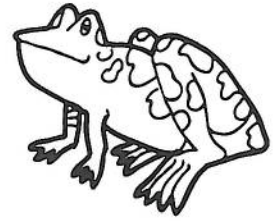
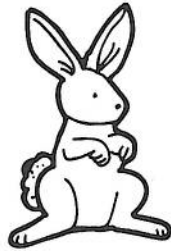
### What You Need

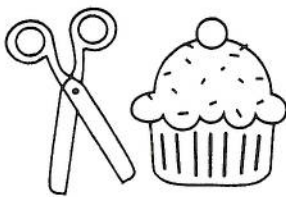
- duplicated page

## craft/snack

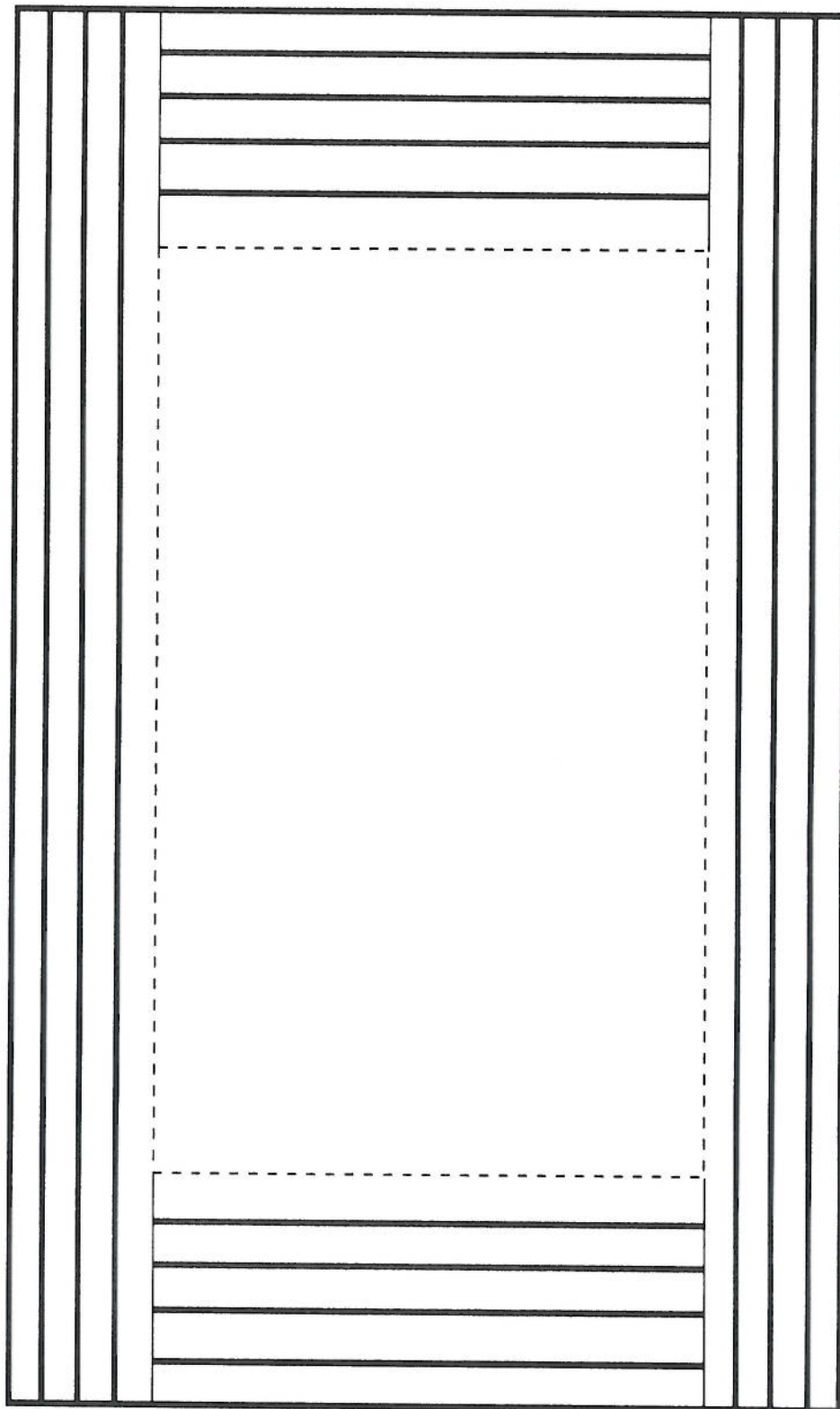
### What You Need

### What to Do

1. Before class, cut out an ark for each child. Fold the ark on the dashed lines and tape the ends to form a box shape.
2. Give each child an ark, a graham cracker and some animal crackers.
3. Help the children spread some frosting on the graham cracker. Have the children stand some animals in the frosting.
4. Place the graham cracker inside the ark box. Say, **Noah gathered two of each animal and took them inside the ark.**
5. The children may eat some of the crackers as they work.
