

The "Great Galilean Ministry" Continues  
*(Choosing The 12, Teaching About The Kingdom)*  
Luke 6



Introduction

Jesus continues His early journeys throughout Galilee. By this time, He has been to Jerusalem and come back (cp. Jn. 5; Mk. 3:7). He hand picks His apostles so that they might begin their "training" (Mk. 3:13). Having already begun preaching the kingdom (Mk. 1:14-15), Jesus commences to explain the doctrine that will characterize His kingdom and its citizens.

Sabbath Situations (6:1-11)

- 1) What did Jesus' disciples do one Sabbath? (v. 1) How did the Pharisees react? (v. 2) What do you think they meant by "not lawful?" (cp. Deut. 23:25)
  
- 2) How does Jesus answer them? (vv. 3-4) What did the example of David's actions prove?
  
- 3) What conclusion did Jesus offer? (v. 5)
  
- 4) What happened on another Sabbath? (v. 6) What were the scribes & Pharisees doing and what was motivating them? (v. 7)
  
- 5) What thinking of the Jews does Jesus expose? (vv. 8-9; cp. Mt. 12:11-12)
  
- 6) What was the Jews' reaction to what Jesus did? (vv. 10-11; cp. Mt. 12:14; Mk. 3:6)
