Lesson Twelve Study Questions

– Raising the Widow's Son at Nain (Luke 7:11-17)

1. To what city did Jesus travel the day after He healed the centurion's servant? (Luke 7:11)
 - Who traveled with Him?
 - What event occurred near the city of Nain in Shunem in 2 Kings 4:8-37?
2. As Jesus and His followers neared the gate of the city, who was being carried out? (Luke 7:12)
 - Whose son was he?
 - Who was with her coming out of the city?
3. What special instructions had been given to Israel by the Lord for the care and consideration of widows? (see Deuteronomy 14:29; 24:17-21; 27:19; Isaiah 1:17; Zechariah 7:10)
 - Should similar loving concern be shown to widows today? (1 Timothy 5; James 1:27)
 - What are some of the forms of mistreatment that widows in Bible times might suffer at the hand of wicked men? (see Psalm 94:6; Isaiah 1:23; 10:1-2; Ezekiel 22:6-7; Matthew 23:14; Luke 20:47)
4. When the Lord saw the widow, what emotion did He feel? (Luke 7:13)
 - According to Deuteronomy 10:18 and Psalm 146:9, what is the Lord God disposed to do on behalf of widows?
 - What did Jesus tell the widow?
5. What did Jesus do to the open coffin? (Luke 7:14-15)
 - What did Jesus say?
 - What did the man in the coffin do?
6. What came upon all who saw this miracle? (Luke 7:16)
 - What did the people say as they glorified God?
 - Explain the basic meaning of the phrase "God has visited His people." (consider its meaning in the following passages: Luke 1:68; Jeremiah 29:10; 15:15; Psalm 106:4)
7. According to John 5:20-21, why did Jesus promise to do "greater works"?
 - What power is shared by God the Father and God the Son?
 - What question is asked by Paul in Acts 26:8?
