Hebrews 9: 11-17

## Lesson 14: Provisions of the Blood of the New Covenant

1. Christ came as a High Priest of what things? (9:11)
2. How is the tabernacle in which Christ serves as High Priest described in Hebrews 9:11?
3. Christ did not enter the Most Holy Place with the blood of bulls and goats, but rather with what? (9:12)
  - How often did He do this?
  - What did He obtain?
  - With what has Christ redeemed men? (cf. Revelation 5:9; 1 Peter 1:18-19)
4. Under the old covenant, what was purified or cleansed by sprinkling the unclean with the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer? (9:13)
5. What is cleansed by the blood of Christ (9:14)
  - From what is the conscience cleansed?
    - What are dead works? (Ephesians 2:1)
    - What must we do about our dead works? (Hebrews 6:1)
  - We are cleansed in order to do what?
    - According to 2 Timothy 2:21, what must one do to become a vessel of honor, useful for service to the Master?
6. Christ is the mediator of a new covenant by means of what? (9:15)
  - What did the death of Christ accomplish for those who lived under the old covenant? (cf. Romans 3:24-25)
  - What does the work of Christ enable “those who are called” to receive?
  - What do we call a document that states who the heirs of an inheritance will be?
7. What must of necessity occur before a testament can be in force (9:16-17)
  - While a testator lives, does his testament have any power or force?
  - Was Christ still alive when He spoke to the thief on the cross? (Luke 23:39-43)
  - What did He promise the thief?
  - Before a testator dies, may he give away his possessions to whomever he chooses?
  - While he lived on earth, could Christ give a person forgiveness? (see Matthew 9:6)
  - After Christ died, what document would determine who the heirs of His inheritance will be?
  - What had some of the Corinthians done to change their status from those who would not receive an inheritance to those who would? (1 Corinthians 6:9-11)
  - What must one do to receive forgiveness and an inheritance according to Acts 26:18?
  - How does one become a son of God and an heir according to Galatians 3:26-29?
