6. What should we not forsake? (10:25)
 - Define the word *forsake*.
 - Instead of forsaking assembling, what should we do more and more?
 - What *day* is being referred to in this passage? Would you agree that whatever *day* is under consideration, seeing it approach should motivate the Hebrew Christians to be more faithful in their attendance and more determined to encourage one another?
 - Is it the day of one's death? (Ecclesiastes 8:8)
 - Is it the first day of the week? (Acts 20:7)
 - Is it the destruction of Jerusalem? (Matthew 24:15-16, 32-34)
 - Is it the day of final judgment? (Hebrews 10:26-31; Acts 17:31; 2 Peter 3:10-12)
7. What are the consequences of sinning willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth? (10:26-27)
8. What happened to anyone who rejected Moses' law? (10:28; cf. Deuteronomy 17:6-7)
 - Should someone who rejects the covenant of Christ be punished more severely or less severely than one who rejected Moses' law? (10:29; 2:2-3)
 - What three things is such a person guilty of according to Hebrews 10:29?
9. What did the Hebrews need to recall? (10:32)
 - What had made them a public spectacle or gazing stock? (10:33, cf. Acts 8:3; 12:1-3)
 - What had they joyfully accepted? (10:34)
 - What did they know they possessed? (10:34b. cf. Matt. 6:19-21; 19:21; 1 Peter 1:4)
 - Why shouldn't they cast away their confidence? (10:35)
 - Why did they need endurance or patience? (10:36)
10. What does the Lord say about someone who draws back from a life of faith? (10:38)
