Lesson 19: Of Whom the World Was Not Worthy

1. By faith, who hid Moses for three months after he was born? (11:23)
 - What were the names of Moses' parents? (Exodus 6:20)
 - What two reasons are given for hiding Moses?
 - Who raised Moses and what kind of education did Moses receive? (Acts 7:21-22)
2. What did Moses refuse to do when he came of age? (11:24-26)
 - What did he choose rather than the passing pleasures of sin?
 - What did he think was more valuable than the treasures of Egypt?
 - What did he look to?
 - When Moses forsook Egypt, why didn't he fear the wrath of the king? (11:27)
 - What did Moses believe would happen if he failed to "keep the Passover and the sprinkling of blood"? (11:28)
3. How many days did the Israelites encircle Jericho before the walls fell down? (11:30)
 - Had God given Jericho to the Israelites before they marched around it? (Joshua 6:2-3)
 - Was it necessary for the Israelites to march around Jericho in order to receive what God had already given them?
4. What did Rahab do by faith? (11:31)
 - In Hebrews 11:31, this event in the life of Rahab is used as an example of faith. In James 2:25, the same event is used as an example of what?
5. What other great characters of faith are listed in Hebrews 11:32?
6. In Hebrews 11:33-35, faithful children of God in the Old Testament are said to have accomplished many great deeds by faith.
 - From Judges 14:5-6 and 1 Samuel 17:34-37 name two men who "stopped the mouths of lions."
 - From Daniel 3:19-28, name three men who "quenched the violence of fire."
 - Who "escaped the edge of the sword" in 1 Kings 19:9-10?
 - In Judges 16:26-30, who "out of weakness" was "made strong"?
 - From Judges 6 & 7, name a judge who "became valiant in battle and turned to flight the armies of the aliens."
 - Name the two prophets in 1 Kings 17:17-24 and 2 Kings 4:32-37 who worked miracles enabling women to receive "their dead raised to life again."
7. List the persecutions and hardships that people of faith endured according to Hebrews 11:35-37.
 - Was the world worthy of such people?
 - Which hero of faith was beaten and put in prison in Jeremiah 20:2?
 - Who was stoned in 2 Chronicles 24:20-21?
8. Although these heroes obtained a good report for their lives of faith, what didn't they receive? (11:39)
 - What has God provided for us? (11:40)
 - Without us, these heroes of faith are not what?
