 - What were his sisters' names?
 - How did Jesus feel about these individuals? (John 11:3, 5)
3. After Jesus heard that Lazarus was sick, how long did He tarry in the place where He was? (John 11:6)
 - When Jesus announces that they are to go to Judah again, how do the disciples respond? (John 11:8)
 - For what purpose does Jesus want to go to Lazarus? (John 11:9)
 - Why does Jesus say that He was glad that He was not there when Lazarus died? (John 11:15)
 - What does Thomas say to his fellow disciples? (John 11:16)
4. How long had Lazarus been dead when Jesus arrived in Bethany? (John 11:17)
 - How near was Jerusalem to Bethany? (John 11:18)
 - Martha went out of her house to meet Jesus. What is the first thing she says to Him? (John 11:21)
 - Does she believe that Jesus might still be able to do something for her brother? (John 11:22)
 - Is Martha confident that her brother will rise from the dead in the resurrection on the last day? (11:23-24)
5. In John 11:25-26, Jesus asks Martha if she believes what?
6. When Mary comes to meet Jesus, what is the first thing she says? (John 11:32)
7. From John 11:33-38, what are some of the factors that caused Jesus to be troubled in His spirit and weep?
8. When Jesus tells them to "take away the stone" from Lazarus' tomb, what objection does Martha make? (John 11:39)
 - Of what does Jesus remind Martha?
9. What does Jesus do before raising Lazarus? (John 11:41-42)
 - For whose benefit does Jesus do this?
10. What did Jesus do to raise Lazarus? (John 11:43)
 - According to John 5:28-29, an hour is coming when what will happen?
11. What opposite reactions did people have to this miracle? (John 11:45-53)
