



The Journey To Jerusalem Concludes The Entry Into Jerusalem & Start Of Last Week Luke 19

Introduction

Following His encounter with Zacchaeus in Jericho, Jesus begins His final ascent into Jerusalem. More than likely, He would have arrived in Bethany on Friday before sundown to observe the Sabbath (Jn. 12:1). The day after the Sabbath, Jesus makes His *Triumphal Entry* (Jn. 12:12), and begins a week full of confrontations with the Jews as well as final and private instructions for His 12 apostles.

Encounter With Zacchaeus (19:1-10)

- 1) Where does Jesus come to? (v. 1) Who is described in vv. 2-4?
- 2) What did Jesus say to Zacchaeus, and what did the publican do? (vv. 5-6) Again, what "typical" reaction did the Jews display? (v. 7; cp. 7:36-39; 15:1-2)
- 3) How was Zacchaeus changed that day because of his encounter with Jesus? (v. 8)
- 4) What did Jesus say in response to Zacchaeus' repentance? (vv. 9-10)

Parable Of The Minas [Pounds] (19:11-27)

- 5) What prompted Jesus to tell this parable? (v. 11)
- 6) Give details of this parable. (vv. 12-27) Research: what is a "mina" or a "pound?"
