Introduction

Well into His 2nd year of public preaching, Jesus’ popularity remains high, albeit for the wrong reasons. This will soon force Him to withdraw from the public, thwarting the people’s efforts to make Him a political king. For now, He continues to mix His teaching with His miracles, hoping to convince people to listen to His message.
