Topic For This Lesson → BAPTISM

Biblical Points Of Emphasis

- ◆ It is for the remission of sins (Acts 2:38)
 - ◆ It is a complete burial (Rom. 6:4; Col. 2:11-12)
 - ◆ It is for those who understand and believe (Mk. 16:16; Acts 8:36-37)
 - ◆ It requires much water (Jn. 3:23; Acts 8:38-39)
 - ◆ It saves (1 Pet. 3:21)
 - ◆ It washes away sins (Acts 22:16)
 - ◆ It must be included if one wants to "preach Christ" (Acts 8:35-36)
 - ◆ It puts one into Christ (Gal. 3:26-27)
 - We need to be "in Christ" to enjoy spiritual blessings (Eph. 1:3)
 - ◆ It puts one into Christ's death...where He shed His blood (Rom. 6:3)
 - It is in His blood where redemption and forgiveness is found (Eph. 1:7)
 - ◆ It makes one a disciple of Christ (Mt. 28:19)
 - ◆ It indicates one has been "born again" (Jn. 3:3, 5)
 - ◆ It is how we are "sanctified" and "cleansed" (Eph. 5:26)
