### The Effects Of Sin

#### **Introduction**

In preparing their players for an important game, coaches will sometimes say... "*The best offense is a good defense.*" The point behind this statement is that stopping your opponent is as, if not more, important than scoring points yourself.

This truism won't just help athletic teams win games. It is also helpful in a more important "contest"... our constant battle against sin. If we maintained a healthy view of sin's power & potential, and the great havoc it can bring in our lives, perhaps we would do a better job of avoiding it.
