

The Bible Doctrine Of Sin

Lesson 8

DAVID (Psalms 32, 51)

<< GOOD >>

[NOTE: We previously discussed his sinful behavior and inappropriate actions (pgs. 9, 11). This lesson will emphasize his proper reactions once he repented (2 Sam. 12:13).]

5) What terms did he use to describe his actions? (Psa. 51:1-4; 2 Sam. 11:27b)

6) How did he feel about his actions? (Psa. 51:3b, 4a, 8b)

7) What did he desire? (Psa. 51:1-2)

8) What did he know his sin prevented? (Psa. 51:11, 13m, 14-19)

[NOTE: Psalm 32 was apparently written after Psalm 51. David expressed a desire to teach transgressors (Psa. 51:13). This psalm was his efforts to do so.]

9) What joys does he express as a forgiven & cleansed man? (Psa. 32:1-2)

10) What failure ("*bad reaction*") does he admit? (Psa. 32:3-4)

11) What success did he enjoy? (Psa. 32:5, 7, 10)
