Christians

- All Christians have instructions to follow and characteristics to possess
- Galatians 5:22-26
 - "Fruits of the Spirit"
- Colossians 3:5-9
 - "Put on and put away"
- I Peter 3:8-12



- Genesis 2:18, 24
 - Helper-- support, encourage, pray for
 - Leave parents
 - God made this point before earthly parents existed
 - One with husband
 - Help guide and balance each other
 - Listen to thoughts, ideas, plans
 - Help consider all sides, different views



- Titus 2:3-5
 - Reverent-- sacred, like holiness
 - Not slandering-- not accusing falsely, not finding faults with others and spreading criticisms
 - Not a drinker
 - Teacher-- train, instruct
 - Older teach the younger
 - Younger "be taught" by the older



- Titus 2:3-5
 - Discreet-- sound-minded, self-controlled, sensible
 - Chaste-- pure in thought and conduct
 - Homemaker-- worker at home, keeper of the home, watching the home (large responsibility!)



- Titus 2:3-5
 - Good-- upright, moral
 - Obedient-- subjection, to listen, submit, to trust
 - Respectful-- in actions and words



- I Peter 3:1-4
 - Submissive to husband-- yielding, following
 - Others won by conduct (example)
 - Chaste
 - Inward beauty-- character of the heart
 - Kindness, gentleness, joyful
 - Gentle, quiet spirit
 - "Very precious in God's sight"



- Colossians 3:18
 - Submissive to own husbands
 - As is fitting in the Lord
 - In accordance with God's law
- God is first, man is 2nd
 - It is so important to have the same goals and beliefs and to know this before marriage.
 - "Will he help you & your children get to Heaven?"



- Deuteronomy 6:5-9
 - Teaching
 - Constantly!! Morning, noon, night, living life right, showing respect, showing submission, living joyful Christian life, by the decisions I make
 - All ages can teach and be taught
 - Conscious effort to be a good example, very conscious effort not to be a stumbling block



- Deuteronomy 6:5-9
 - Respect
 - Important to "Fear God"
 - Authority
 - God's power
 - Obedience
 - God has given patterns and instructions to be followed- do not add or take away- know exactly what He wants and expects



- Proverbs 31:10-31
- High moral standards, chaste
- Valuable, more precious than jewels
- Trusted, gives husband no reason to doubt
- Does good all of her life
- Applies herself, not lazy
- Takes care of her family and others



- Preparing constantly, uses money wisely
- Readies herself
- Helps the needy
- Doesn't fear the future, prepared
- Works for what she has
- Faithful, strong, respected by husband
- Will be rewarded and able to rejoice



- Speaks with wisdom and kindness
- Constantly watching over home and family
- Loved and blessed by children
- Praised by husband
- Inward beauty is praised
- Doesn't brag on self; her works and actions say it all
